## **Community Service Form**

## Service requirements:

9th grade year: 10 hours 11th grade year: 15 hours

10th grade year: 10 hours 12th grade year: 15 hours



## Reminders:

- Community service must be done **OUTSIDE** of the school day.
- **Each time** service is performed, a Community Service Form is to be completed by you and returned to your Theology teacher. A record of your hours is kept by your Theology teacher.
- If you sign up for school sponsored service and it gets cancelled, you will receive ONE hour of service.
  - Try to turn your Service Forms in by the end of the quarter in which they are completed.

    Do not wait until the end of the year to turn in the service hours you completed earlier in the year.
  - Each **12th grader** must have hours completed **by May 1**<sup>st</sup>in order to complete your graduation requirements.
  - Each **11th**, **10th**, **and 9th graders** must have hours completed **by June 1**<sup>st</sup>in order to receive your end-of-year report card and be promoted to the next grade.
  - If hours are not completed by the end of the year, it is your responsibility to make sure the hours are completed over the summer.
    - You will not be able to begin classes in the new school year until your hours have been completed.
  - Helping family members and/or babysitting are not accepted as service hours. Helping family is expected of all students.
  - If you are not sure what counts as service, please check with your Theology teacher.
  - AWARDS BANQUET: awards are given for 30+ and 100+ community service hours. These hours must be recorded and submitted by MAY 1<sup>st</sup>in order to receive an award.
