- E-portfolios document the student's four years of high school

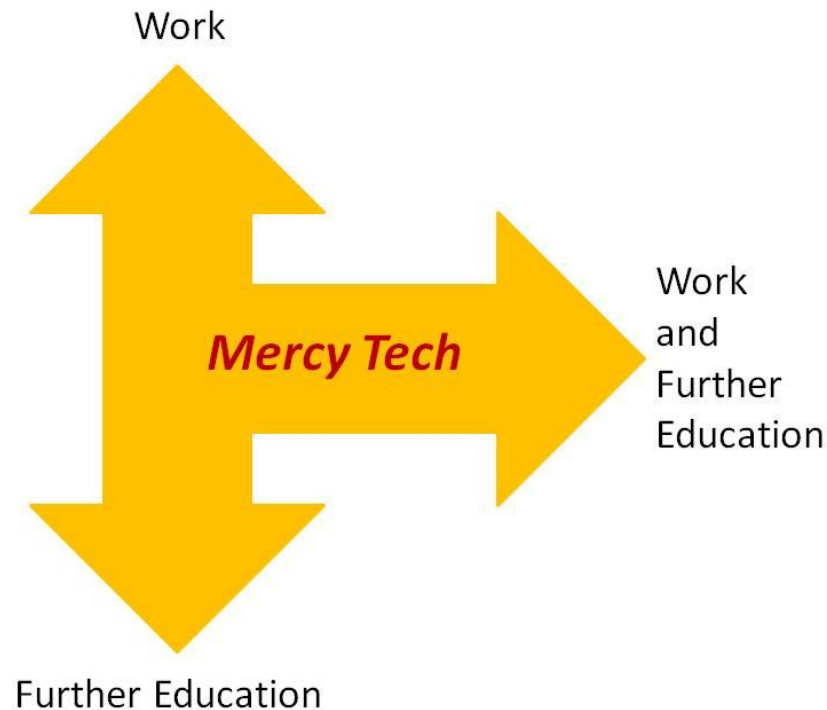


Graduate with Options

Mercy Tech's Response to this Pandemic

- Immediately transitioned to virtual learning in March
 - Followed bell scheduled 8:30 am - 3:08 pm everyday
 - Teachers and students face-to-face but online (Google Meet)
 - Students continued to earn certifications
- Mercy Tech is HYBRID this year
 - Students report two days a week
 - Special days for all CTE
 - Classrooms have desks 6' apart
 - CTE labs sized for safe social distancing
 - Only CTE school opened in Philadelphia
 - **Average daily attendance rate is above 90%**

McAuley Program

- An intensive academic support program for students with learning difficulties.
- A “*select*” program with small class sizes in English and Math
- Strong emphasis on English, Math, Study Skills, and Organizational Skills.
- “*Learning Strategies*” are taught so that they will meet with success.
- 24 students accepted per year.
- Not Special Education program.
- Reading of tests for students, if requested by a teacher.
- Extra tutoring sessions.
- Speech services (CORA).
- In order to apply, a student **MUST** have a recent **Psychological Evaluation** along with other pertinent academic files.

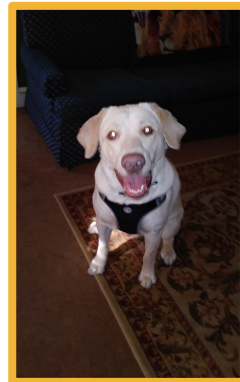

- **Tuition: \$8,495.00**
 - Includes all fees
- **Financial Assistance:**
 - 96% of Mercy Tech families receive over \$1.6 million dollars in grants and scholarships.



- **Mercy Admissions Process:**
 - Apply, Submit Materials (6th, 7th and 8th Grade Report Cards, 8th Teacher Recommendation, Standardized Test Scores) Interview, & Decision Letter
 - **Apply early!** We had to wait list students last year.
- **Getting to Mercy: Transportation**
 - Upper Darby, William Penn, Abington, or Cheltenham School Districts residents are bussed.
 - Free SEPTA transpass (live 1.5 miles or further from Mercy Tech)
 - SEPTA Bus Routes: 1, 32, 48, 60 and R
