

Community Service Form

Service requirements:

Freshman year: 10 hours

Junior year: 15 hours

Sophomore year: 10 hours

Senior year: 15 hours



Reminders:

- Community service must be done **OUTSIDE** of the school day.
- **Each time** service is performed, a Christian Service Form is to be completed by you and returned to your Theology teacher. A record of your hours is kept in Powerschool.
- **Service forms MUST be turned in by the end of the quarter in which they are completed.** Do not wait until the end of the year to turn in the service hours you completed earlier in the year.
- Each **senior** must have hours completed **by May 1st** in order to complete his/her graduation requirements.
- Each **junior, sophomore, and freshman** must have hours completed **by June 1st** in order to receive his/her end-of-year report card and be promoted to the next grade.
- If hours are not completed by the end of the year, it is your PARENT'S/GUARDIAN'S responsibility to make sure the hours are completed over the summer.
- You will not be able to begin class in the new school year until your hours have been completed.
- **Helping family members and/or babysitting are not accepted as service hours.** Helping family is expected of all students.
- If you are not sure about your service activity, please check with your Theology teacher.
- **AWARDS BANQUET:** awards are given for **30+ and 100+ community service hours.** These hours must be recorded in **Powerschool by MAY 1st** in order to receive an award.
